The Constitution prescribes Congressional apportionment based on decennial census population data. Each state has at least one Representative, no 1941 distribution 1 1941, distribur 14 Sresentatives has been based on total U.S. population, so Representative has the least possible variation between one state and any other. Congress fixes the number of voting Representatives at each apportionment. States delineate the district boundaries. The first House of Representatives in 1789 had 65 members; currently there are 435. There are non-voting delegates from American Sum, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands.
