UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT Gen. George W. Casey, Jr. (Cal. No. 15)

Ordered, That at 11:00 a.m., on Thursday, February 8, 2007, the Senate proceed to executive session and resume consideration of the nomination of General George W. Casey, Jr., to be Chief of Staff, United States Army; that there be 30 minutes of debate remaining on the nomination with the time equally divided and controlled between the Senator from Michigan (Mr. Levin) and the Senator from Arizona (Mr. McCain) or their designees; that upon the use or yielding back of time, without further intervening action or debate, the Senate proceed to vote on the confirmation of the nomination; that upon disposition of the nomination, the motion to reconsider be laid upon the table, the President be immediately notified of the Senate's action and the Senate resume legislative session.
