#### UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

#### [ALBERTO R. GONZALES (C. 8)]

Ordered, That at 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, February 2, 2005, the Senate resume consideration of the nomination of Alberto R. Gonzales, of Texas, to be Attorney General, with the time until 4:30 p.m. be equally divided; provided, that the first hour be under the control of the Majority and following that, the time alternate every 60 minutes; provided further, that the time from 2:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. be under the control of the Minority; provided that at 2:30 p.m. the Senator from West Virginia (Mr. Byrd) be recognized for 1 hour and that the time from 4:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. be under the control of the Majority.

Ordered further, That on Thursday, February 3, 2005, following morning business, the Senate resume consideration of the nomination of Alberto R. Gonzales, and that there be an additional 8 hours for debate equally divided between the Chairman of the Committee on the Judiciary (Mr. Specter) and Ranking Member (Mr. Leahy) or their designees; provided further, that following the use or yielding back of time the Senate proceed to a vote on the confirmation of the nomination with no intervening action or debate and that following the vote the President be immediately notified of the Senate's action.
