




What is Linked Data?

- Platform independent way to create relationships between data (not just documents) on the Web
- Eric Miller, co-founder and president of Zepheira, likens Linked Data to legos – the pieces are interchangeable and you can combine them in new and exciting ways
- Our legos are Uniform Resource Identifiers (URIs) and the Resource Description Framework (RDF)

Why Linked Data?

- Machine readable
- Increased interoperability
- Increased transparency
- Better discoverability
- Link concepts between languages
- Disambiguation of terms and concepts
- Allows others to curate/enhance data





The Rules: 5 Star Linked Data

Proposed by Tim Berners-Lee in 2006: http://www.w3.org/DesignIssues/LinkedData.html

*	make your stuff available on the web (whatever format)
**	make it available as structured data (e.g. excel instead of image scan of a table)
***	non-proprietary format (e.g. csv instead of excel)
****	use URLs to identify things, so that people can point at your stuff
****	link your data to other people's data to provide context

Uniform Resource Identifiers (URIs)

- URIs can represent any entity or concept
- When organizations use the same URIs, they are able to link their resources together
- Linking will increase the value of the URIs and build a web of data



Web development

Web development is a broad term for the work involved in developing a web site for the Internet or an intranet (a private network). This can include web design, web content development, client liaison, clientside/server-side scripting, web server and network

- Use within Law.gov
 - browsing tool
 - identify like materials
 - demonstrate relationships (broader, narrower, etc.)




