Collegiate Broadcasters, Inc. Petition to Participate

Pursuant to the "Notice announcing commencement of proceeding with request for Petitions to Participate" (70 FR 7970, February 16, 2005), Collegiate Broadcasters, Inc. (CBI) hereby summits its Petition to Participate (Petition) in the process to establish and/or adjust rates and terms for certain digital public performances of sound recordings under 114(f). This proceeding also encompasses the rates and terms for the making of ephemeral copies in furtherance of the above referenced performances under section 112(e).

CBI is an interested party in these proceedings as it represents electronic college media outlets from across the nation. These student operated media outlets either make transmissions subject to the relevant statutes or are likely to commence transmissions in the near future. CBI has participated in the past recordkeeping proceedings by way of Comments, Reply Comments and participation in the Copyright Office "Roundtable." Further, CBI is a party to the negotiated settlement that established certain rates and terms for specific small webcasters, pursuant to the Small Webcasters Settlement Act (See 68 FR 35008, June 11, 2003).

With this Petition, CBI submits the required filing fee of \$150.
