E the People of the States of New-Hampfhire, Maffachufetts, Rhode-Ifland and Providence Plantations, Connecticut, New-York, New-Jerfey, Pennfylvania, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, North-Carolina, South-Carolina, and Georgia, do ordain, declare and eftablifh the following Conftitution for the Government of Ourfelves and our Pofterity.

The file of this Government fhall be, " The United States of America."

II.

The Government fhall confift of fupreme legislative, executive and judicial powers.

The legiflative power thall be vefted in a Congress, to confift of two feparate and diffinct bodies of men, a Houfe of Representatives, and a Senafe; each of which fluill, in all eafes, have a negative on the other. The Legiflature fluil meet on the first Monday in December in every year.

IV.

Sect. 1. The Members of the Houfe of Reprefentatives shall be chosen every fecond year, by the people of the several States comprehended within this Union. The qualifications of the electors shall be the same, from time to time, as those of the electors in the several States, of the most numerous branch of their own legislatures.

Sect. 2. Every Member of the Houfe of Reprefentatives fhall be of the age of twenty-five years at leaft; fhall have been a citizen in the United States for at leaft three years before his election; and fhall be, at the time of his election, a relident of the State in which he fhall be chofen.

Sect. 3. The Houfe of Reprefentatives shall, at its first formation, and until the number of citizens and inhabitants shall be taken in the manner herein after deferibed, confist of fixty-five Members, of whom three shall be chosen in New-Hampshire, eight in Massachusetts, one in Rhode Island and Providence Plantations, five in Connecticut, fix in New-York, four in New-Jersey, eight in Pennfylvania, one in Delaware, fix in Maryland, ten in Virginia, five in North-Carolina, five in South-Carolina, and three in Georgia.

Seft. 4. As the proportions of numbers in the different States will alter from time to time; as fome of the States may hereafter be divided; as others may be enlarged by addition of territory; as two or more States may be united; as new States will be erected within the limits of the United States, the Legiflature fhall, in each of thefe cafes, regulate the number of reprefentatives by the number of inhabitants, according to the provident the fact that the rate of one for every forty thousand. No money fhall be drawn from the public Treafury, but in purfuance of appropriations that fhall originate in the Houfe of Reprefentatives.

Sect. 6. The Houfe of Reprefertatives fhall have the fole power of impeachment. It fhall choofe its Speaker and other officers.

Sect. 7. Vacancies in the Houfe of Reprefentatives shall be supplied by writs of election from the executive authority of the State, in the reprefentation from which they shall happen. V.
