### **Scope and Content Note**

The papers of Lesley James McNair (1883-1944) span the years 1904-1945, with the bulk of the material concentrated in the period 1941-1945. The collection consists of correspondence, an air travel log, scrapbooks, clippings, memorabilia, and photographs pertaining to McNair's military career. The focus is on World War II, with some material relating to World War I.

### **Arrangement of the Papers**

This collection is organized by type of material and is mainly comprised of oversize scrapbooks.
