

Resolution 422 and rule XXIII, declared the House resolved into the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union for the further consideration of the bill (H.R. 518) to designate certain lands in the California Desert as wilderness, to establish the Death Valley and Joshua Tree National Parks and the Mojave National Monument, and for other purposes.

The SPEAKER pro tempore, Mr. MONTGOMERY, by unanimous consent, designated Mr. PETERSON of Florida, as Chairman of the Committee of the Whole; and after some time spent therein,

Amendment submitted by Mr. THOMAS of California:

On page 6, delete lines 13 through 22 and insert the following in lieu thereof: "(1) Certain lands in the California Desert Conservation Area, the Bureau of Land Management which comprise approximately seventy-four thousand two hundred and fifty acres, as generally depicted on a map entitled 'Argus Range Wilderness—Proposed 1', dated May 1991, and two maps entitled 'Argus Range Wilderness—Proposed 2', dated January 1989, and Argus Range Wilderness—Proposed 3', dated May 1994, and which shall be known as the Argus Range Wilderness."

Amendment submitted by Mr. MILLER of California:

Revise the amendment to read as follows:

On page 6, line 24, after the period add the following:

If at any time within 15 years after the date of enactment of this Act the Secretary of the Navy notifies the Secretary of the Interior that permission has been granted to use lands within the area of the China Lake Naval Air Warfare Center for installation of a space energy laser facility, and that establishment of a right-of-way across lands within the Argus Range Wilderness is desirable in order to facilitate access to the lands to be used for such facility, the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976, may grant a right-of-way for, and authorize construction of, a road to be used solely for that purpose across such lands, notwithstanding the designation of such lands as wilderness. So far as practicable, any such road shall be aligned in a manner that takes into account the desirability of minimizing adverse impacts on wilderness values.

Page 34, after line 25, insert the following: LAW ENFORCEMENT ACCESS

SEC. 112. Nothing in this Act, including the wilderness designations made by this Act, may be construed to preclude Federal, State, and local law enforcement agencies from conducting law enforcement and border operations as permitted before the enactment of this Act, including the use of motor vehicles and aircraft, on any lands designated as wilderness by this Act.
