The SPEAKER pro tempore, Mr. MAZZOLI, assumed the Chair.

When Mr. BOUCHER, Chairman, reported that the Committee, having had under consideration said bill, had directed him to report the same back to the House with sundry amendments adopted by the Committee with the recommendation that the amendments be agreed to and that the bill, as amended, do pass.

By unanimous consent, the previous question was ordered on the bill.

The following amendments, reported from the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union, were agreed to:

Page 33, line 14, strike the colon and all that follows through "101-576" on line 17.

Page 34, strike line 17 and all that follows through "That" on line 25.

Page 57, after line 7, insert the following new section:

SEC. 339. The amount otherwise provided by this Act for "DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION—OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY—Salaries and Expenses" is hereby increased by \$26,300,000, of which amount \$8,300,000 shall be derived from amounts provided for in this Act under the heading "INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION—Salaries and Expenses".

Page 50, strike lines 8 through 10.

Page 57, after line 7, insert the following new section:

SEC. 339. (a) PURCHASE OF AMERICAN-MADE EQUIPMENT AND PRODUCTS.—It is the sense of the Congress that, to the greatest extent practicable, all equipment and products purchased with funds made available in this Act should be American-made.

(b) NOTICE REQUIREMENT.—In providing financial assistance to, or entering into any contract with, any entity using funds made available in this Act, the head of each Federal agency, to the greatest extent practicable, shall provide to such entity a notice describing the statement made in subsection (a) by the Congress.

The bill, as amended, was ordered to be engrossed and read a third time, was read a third time by title.
