Administration's Procedures for Reconsidering Analysis

In years past, some Members and constituent companies have had questions or concerns with the Administration's analysis on particular MTBs and subsequently requested that the Administration reconsider its views. The Administration strives to make every effort to consider all applicable information and discuss the basis for its views. The Administration has developed the following procedures under which it will consider a request to re-review its analysis or provide additional explanation.

Procedure:

- 1. The Administration will receive requests to re-review its view on an MTB through November 16, 2012.
- 2. All requests for reconsideration must be submitted in writing to Rebecca.Gudicello@trade.gov.
- 3. The written request should contain supplementary information about the bill and the covered-product in question. Examples of constructive supplementary information include: additional information about the product's nature and end-use, responses to issues raised in public objection letters, or responses to technical comments from the Administration.
- 4. After the Administration has reviewed the supplementary information, it will contact the Members' staff and/or constituent companies to schedule meetings as needed.
