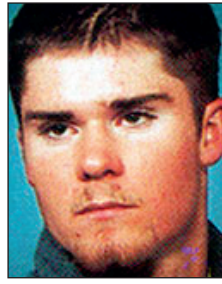


Master Sgt. Evander Earl Andrews, 36

Killed when the UH-60 Black Hawk helicopter he was in crashed in Pakistan.
