Of course the Copyright Office should provide an option for filing Notices of Intention to obtain a Section 115 compulsory license with the Copyright Office by electronically filing.

If done properly this could automate much of the process.

Congress should be encouraged to change the law to allow electronic filing of all such notices.

The copyright office can then pass the information to the copyright holder electronically. Most music is licensed by the composer associations, which will benefit from electronic filing.

Composers without email are likely few enough, for the Copyright Office to mail the notice to.
