Ordered, That at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, September 10, 2007, the Senate proceed to executive session to consider en bloc the nominations of William Lindsay Osteen, Jr., of North Carolina, to be United States District Judge for the Middle District of North Carolina, Martin Karl Reidinger, of North Carolina, to be United States District Judge for the Western District of North Carolina, and Janis Lynn Sammartino, to be United States District Judge for the Southern District of California; that there be 60 minutes for debate on the nominations, equally divided between the Chairman and the Ranking Member of the Committee on the Judiciary or their designees; provided further, that at 11 a.m. the Senate proceed to vote on the Osteen nomination, followed by votes on the Reidinger and Sammartino nominations; provided further, that the motions to reconsider be laid on the table; the President be immediately notified of the Senate's action and the Senate then return to legislative session.
