#### UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

*Ordered further,* That following the use or yielding back of time the Senate proceed to a vote on the confirmation, with no intervening action or debate; further, that following the vote the President be immediately notified of the Senate's action, and the Senate then resume legislative session.
