The Thrifty Food Plan is based on 1989-91 data and the other three food plans are based on 1977-78 data; all four plans are updated to current dollars using the Consumer Price Index for specific food items.

²The costs given are for individuals in 4-person families. For individuals in other size families, the following adjustments are suggested: 1-person—add 20 percent; 2-person—add 10 percent; 3-person—add 5 percent; 5- or 6-person—subtract 5 percent; 7- (or more) person—subtract 10 percent.
