## Special Counsel Encouraged by Disciplinary Actions for Retaliation at Port Mortuary

Special Counsel Carolyn Lerner released the following statement on the disciplinary actions announced by the U.S. Air Force against Col. Robert Edmonson and Mr. Trevor Dean. In March, the Office Special Counsel found that Col. Edmonson and Mr. Dean retaliated against whistleblowers at the Air Force Mortuary Affairs Operation (AFMAO) Center, Dover Air Base.

"I am encouraged by the disciplinary actions announced today against the individuals who retaliated against whistleblowers at Port Mortuary. These actions send a strong signal that employees at all levels will be held accountable for whistleblower reprisal. I look forward to working with Air Force leadership to strengthen whistleblower training and education efforts so that all employees know they can bring government misconduct to light without fear of retaliation."
