

## **COLONEL JEFFREY C. POWELL**

Colonel Jeffrey C. "Jeff" Powell is a native of Bangor, Maine. He enlisted as a Private in Field Artillery entering active duty in 1983. Upon completing a two year enlistment, he attended the University of Maine and was commissioned in 1989. Colonel Powell holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Business from the University of Maine, a Master's of Business Administration from Syracuse University and a Master's degree in National Security and Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College. His military education includes the Field Artillery Basic Course and Finance Advanced Course, Combined Arms and Services Staff School, the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College, and the U.S. Army War College. During more than 25 years of active service, he has commanded and worked in key staff positions from Detachment to Theater, with duty in Afghanistan, Croatia, Germany, Italy and the United States.
