1. To support the Secretary's vision for creating a 21st century VA, and to achieve the CIO's five main priorities of improving customer service, managing projects to an outcome, providing operational metrics, ensuring information protection, and improving financial reporting, the Office of Information and Technology (OI&T) has undergone a period of review and assessment. The resulting organizational readjustments have been developed to transform OI&T and to meet the Secretary's vision and CIO's priorities.

2. The efforts of OI&T's senior leaders in preparing for this reorganization efforts of OI&T's senior leaders in preparing for this reorganization are greatly appreciated. These initial steps include the establishment of the office of Architecture, Strategy and Design; the creation of advocates for health, benefits, and corporate customers; and streamlining of the Product Development organization.

3. We are now ready to follow through with the remaining adjustments to the organization in preparation for FY2011. It is necessary that designated positions be reorganized within OI&T to complete the organizational readjustment.

4. Attached is the updated OI&T organization chart. The implementation date of the organizational adjustment is October 1, 2010. The personnel actions must be effective no earlier than October 10, 2010 and no later than December 19, 2010.

5. Implementing instructions for this organizational adjustment will be provided to OI&T's senior leaders shortly. Thank you for your continued cooperation in assisting VA OI&T in becoming a 21st century organization and achieving the CIO's five priorities.

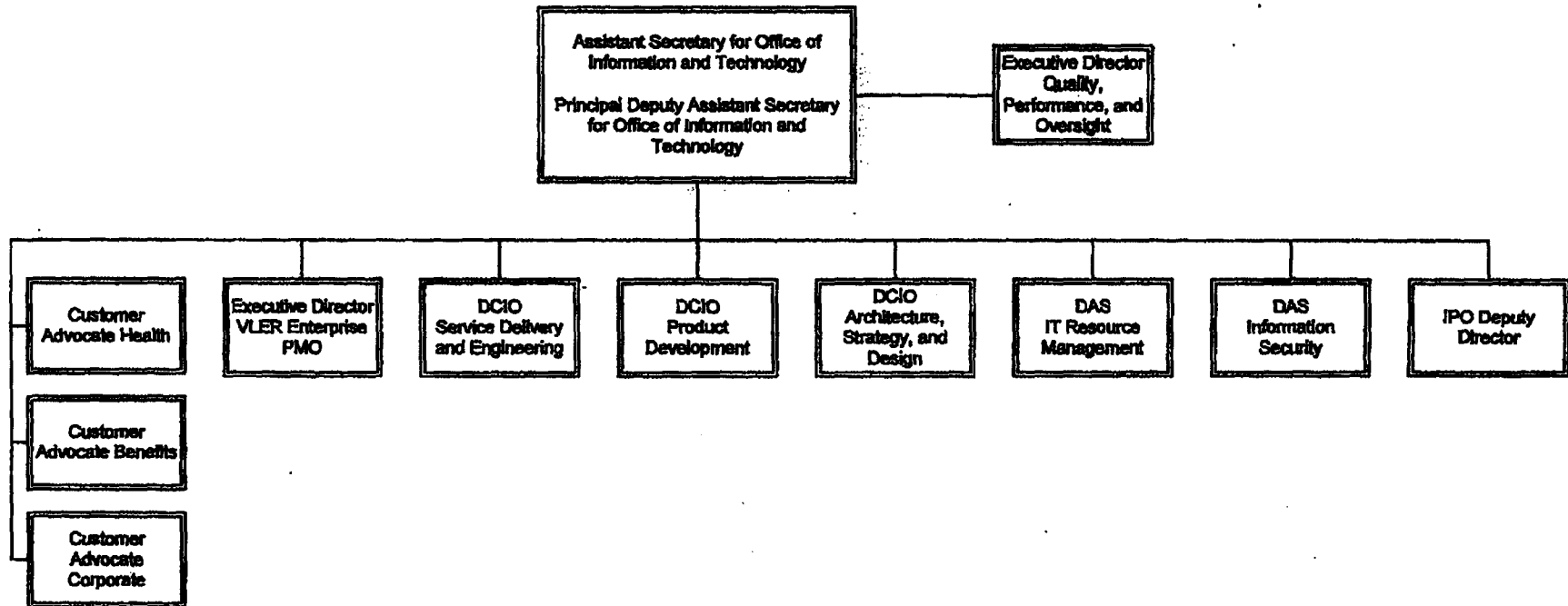

Information Protection and Risk Management (IPRM)**



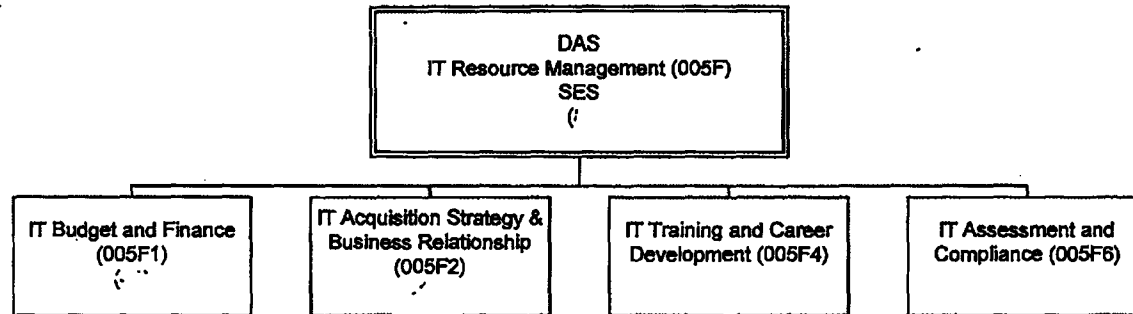

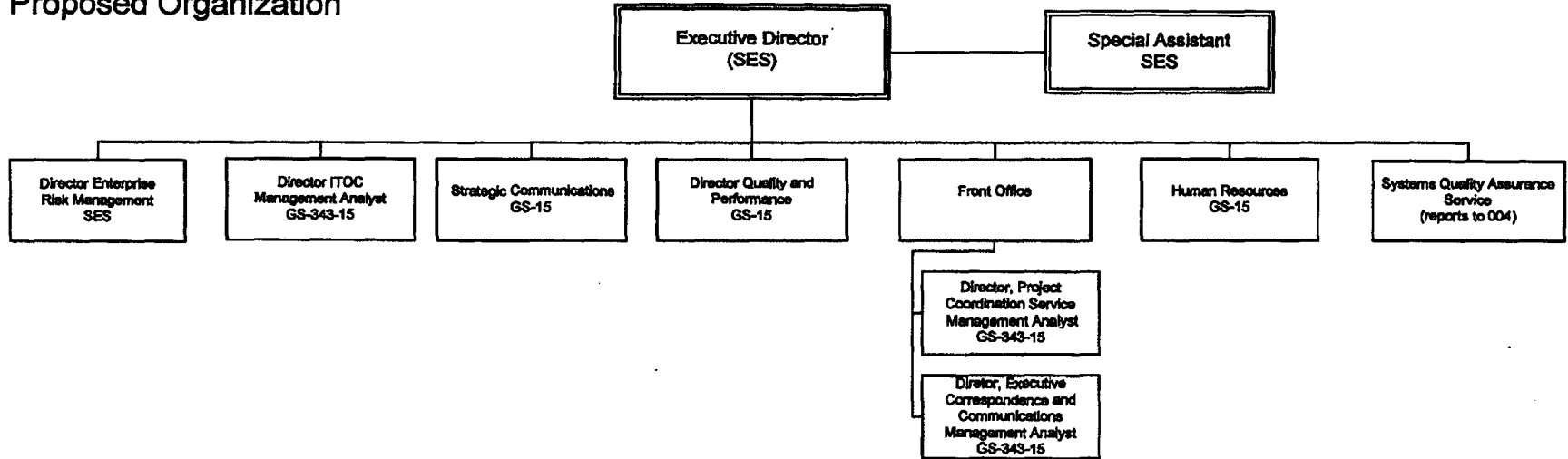


