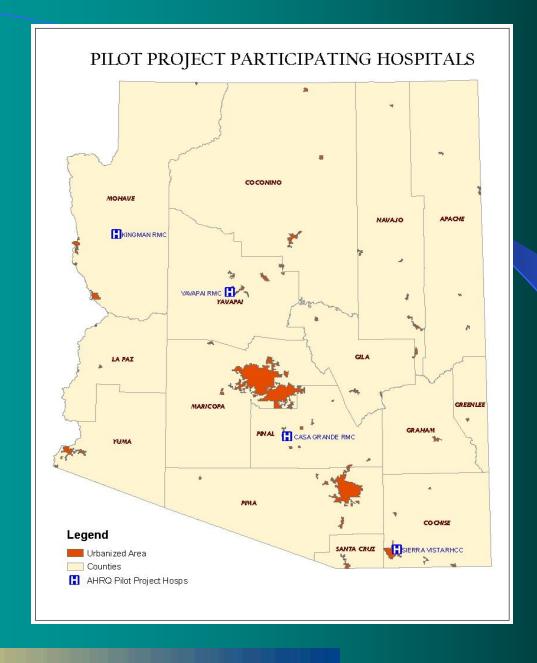

CHALLENGES

- AHRQ
 - Software/documentation changes
 - Manual abstraction
 - Empirical rates
 - QI Software training

- Hospitals
 - Different chart types and charting methods
 - Coding inconsistencies
 - Adherence to internal coding procedures





CHALLENGES cont'd

- ADHS
 - IT constraints
 - Limited coding/abstraction staff
 - Time/Labor intensive
 - Funding





Lessons Learned

- All hospital data to determine AZ baselines
- ADHS Project design
- Incorporate with data audit process
- Automate abstraction
- Training Training
- Funding
