

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q What's the purpose of the shuttle service?
- A To provide transportation for personnel to designated stops from the Pentagon Transit Center (PTC) to North Parking.
- Q How frequent will the Circulator run?
- A Every 20 minutes.
- Q What are the hours of the Pentagon Circulator?
- A Operation hours are from 6:00AM 6:00PM with the last run leaving the PTC Upper Level 8 (U8) bus bay at 5:40PM.
- Q How many stops does the Pentagon Circulator have and where do they stop?
- A There are 5 stops. The first stop is at the PTC bus bay U8. The stops leaving from and returning to bay U8 are as follows:
 - 1. Connector Road
 - 2. North Parking (across from PENREN)
 - 3. North Parking
 - 4. Mid-North Parking
 - 5. Pentagon Conference Center & Library (PLC2)
- Q Who should I contact if the shuttle bus is running late?
- **A** Call (703) 604-0637.
- Q Can I take pictures on the shuttle bus?
- A Using cameras and video cameras is prohibited on the Pentagon Reservation.
- Q Is the Pentagon Circulator handicap accessible?
- A Yes, please contact (703) 604-0637 if special arrangements are needed.
- Q Does the Circulator run on weekends and holidays?
- A No.



PENTAGONCIRCULATOR



- The Pentagon Circulator will provide convenient transportation for all personnel from the Pentagon Transit Center to North and Boundary Channel Parking.
- Beginning at the Pentagon Transit Center (PTC) from bus bay Upper Level 8 (U8), the Pentagon Circulator will pick-up and drop-off at five locations, including Connector Road, three North Parking locations, and the Pentagon Library and Conference Center.
- The Pentagon Circulator will operate on weekdays from 6:00AM to 6:00PM and run every 20 minutes. The last run will leave the PTC from bus bay U8 at 5:40pm.
