CEMENT IN FEBRUARY 2012

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers and the production of clinker in the United States from January 2011 through the current month.¹ Data on the imports of cement and clinker for the current month are also provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico for February 2012 were 4.7 million metric tons (Mt). This was almost 29% higher than shipments in February 2011 (tables 2A and 2B). Shipments for the year through February were 9.3 Mt, up by about 26%. Although continuing a trend of monthly increases that started in May 2011, the high percentage increase in January and February 2012 in part reflected mild winter weather conditions. The leading producing States in February were Texas, California, Missouri, Florida, and Alabama, in descending order (table 1A). The leading consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Louisiana, and Pennsylvania, in descending order) received about 43% of the February total shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Clinker production totaled 4.2 Mt in February, nearly 21% higher than output in February 2011 (table 4). Production for the year through February was 8.4 Mt, up by 21.5%. The leading

clinker-producing States in February were Texas, California, Missouri, Florida, and South Carolina, in descending order, and these together accounted for 52% of the February total.

Masonry cement shipments in February of about 134,000 metric tons (t) were about 19% higher than the very low volumes in February 2011 (table 2C); again, some of this increase was attributable to mild weather conditions. Shipments for the year through February were 264,000 t, also up by 19%. The leading consuming States, in descending order, were Florida, Texas, California, North Carolina, and Georgia, and these received about 49% of February's total shipments.

Tables 5, 6, and 7 contain import data from the U.S. Census Bureau. Data for clinker imports into the Seattle and possibly the Detroit customs districts are likely incomplete owing to some shipments arriving overland from Canada on an informal entry basis. February 2012 imports of cement and clinker of about 291,000 t were about 20% lower than in February 2011, but may have reflected early arrival of some ships in January. Imports for the year through February were 664,000 t, up by 19%.
