MARKETABLE PHOSPHATE ROCK—CROP YEAR 2011

U.S. production of marketable phosphate rock was 26.5 million metric tons (Mt) in Crop Year 2011 (July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011) a slight decrease compared with 26.7 Mt in Crop Year 2010.

Data for this report were collected through semi-annual canvasses of U.S. phosphate rock producers. All companies that produced phosphate rock in the United States participated in the voluntary surveys, representing 100% of the production, use, and value data shown in the tables.

Marketable phosphate rock used was 28.1 Mt, a slight increase compared with 28 Mt in Crop Year 2010. There were no reported sales of phosphate rock. The manufacturing of wet-process phosphoric acid for fertilizers and animal feed supplements was estimated to have accounted for more than 95% of phosphate rock consumption. The remainder was used to produce elemental phosphorus, defluorinated phosphate rock, or direct application to soil.

Estimated domestic phosphate rock consumption increased slightly to 30.6 Mt in Crop Year 2011from 30.1 Mt in Crop Year 2010. Producers' stocks decreased by 29%, to 5.37 Mt in Crop Year 2011, from 7.57 Mt in Crop Year 2010.

The average value of marketable phosphate rock sold or used in the United States was \$92.31 per metric ton, compared with \$64.78 per ton in Crop Year 2010. Imports of phosphate rock were estimated to be 2.49 Mt, using U.S. Census Bureau trade data and other sources, because some import tonnage and value data for phosphate rock imports were not reported by Census. There were no reported exports of phosphate rock by mining companies in Crop Year 2011.
