## **SCHOOL TOUR GUIDELINES**

- Students visiting as an organized school group are admitted free of charge to the
  Eisenhower Museum. We also admit one adult free for each five students in your group.
  Additional adults will be charged the adult rate of \$8.00 per person. Students MUST stay
  with their adult sponsors at all times.
- Upon arriving at the Eisenhower Center, please check in at the Gift Shop located in the Visitors Center building.
- Food and drinks, including gum and candy, are **NOT** allowed in any of the buildings.
- When visiting the Boyhood Home, we request your whole group visit at one time. A guide will
  tell the history of the Eisenhower Home and family from the front porch. Your group will then
  be allowed to tour the home and ask any questions they might have.

### SCHOOL STUDENT/ADULT RATIO CHART

A ratio of one adult for every five students will be allowed into the museum free of charge. Any additional adults will be charged the adult admission fee.

# TO PROTECT OUR MUSEUM AND TO ENSURE EVERYONE ENJOYS THEIR VISIT, PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES

- Students must be respectful of the exhibits and other visitors.
- Students will stay with their sponsors at all times, including in the Gift Shop.

- Students will speak in low voices in the buildings.
- No running in the buildings.
- Flash photography is not allowed in any of the buildings. Bring only cameras which do not have a
  flash or cameras which can have the flash turned off.
- With the exception of those unable to use stairs, students will not use the elevators or wheelchair lifts.
- Do not touch or write on paintings, exhibits, walls or glass cases.

#### **EXPECTATIONS FOR CHAPERONES**

There are certain things that you can do to make your group's visit to the Eisenhower Center more enjoyable

- Set the tone for the visit. Your respect for the public facility and your responsiveness to the teacher's goals are all passed on to the students.
- **Stay with your group**. This is an opportunity to help and to interact with students, not a personal tour.
- Find out as much as possible from the teacher about the focus for this visit. Make sure to use and hold onto any materials or information that the teacher provides for you.
- Encourage students to be considerate of other museum visitors. Please remember, there is no
  running through the buildings, bringing food into the buildings, touching exhibits, and playing in the
  fountains. Photographs are permitted, <u>but no flash may be used!</u>

We hope that these suggestions are helpful to you and that you enjoy your visit to the Eisenhower Center. By abiding by these rules, everyone visiting the Eisenhower Presidential Library and Museum will have a memorable experience.
