The materials in FOIA 2007-1742-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA request 2007-1742-F contains materials from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alpha Files and Subject Files. The topic of this FOIA request concerns Public Law 100-383, the Civil Liberties Act of 1988. The records include drafts and the final version of the apology letter from President Bill Clinton to Japanese Americans held in internment during World War II.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Alpha Files and WHORM Subject Files. WHORM Subject and Alpha Files are processed at the document level.

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993 – 1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons,

organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination.
