² Hypertensive adults as a percent of estimated adult medical patients of ages 18-85.³ Diabetic adults as a percent of estimated adult medical patients of ages 18-75.⁴ Measure was revised in 2011 and is not comparable to calendar year 2010 and prior.⁵ Grantee adjusted quartile results from a statistical model adjusting for special populations, uninsured and minority patients, and EHR use. Clinical performance for each measure is ranked from Quartile 1, highest 25% of reporting grantees, to Quartile 4, lowest 25% of reporting grantees.
