- 2. The following definitions of terms used in this Report:
 - a. **Administrative Appeal** a request to a federal agency asking that it review at a higher administrative level a FOIA determination made by the agency at the initial request level.
 - b. **Average Number** the number obtained by dividing the sum of a group of numbers by the quantity of numbers in the group. For example, of 3, 7, and 14, the average number is 8.
 - c. **Backlog** the number of requests or administrative appeals that are pending at an agency at the end of the fiscal year that are beyond the statutory time period for a response.
 - d. **Component** for agencies that process requests on a decentralized basis, a "component" is an entity, also sometimes referred to as an Office, Division, Bureau, Center, or Directorate, within the agency that processes FOIA requests. The FOIA now requires that agencies include in their Annual FOIA Report data for both the agency overall and for each principal component of the agency.
 - e. **Consultation** the procedure whereby the agency responding to a FOIA request first forwards a record to another agency for its review because that other agency has an interest in the document. Once the agency in receipt of the consultation finishes its review of the record, it responds back to the agency that forwarded it. That agency, in turn, will then respond to the FOIA requester.

- f. **Exemption 3 Statute** a federal statute that exempts information from disclosure and which the agency relies on to withhold information under subsection (b)(3) of the FOIA.
- g. FOIA Request a FOIA request is generally a request to a federal agency for access to records concerning another person (i.e., a "third-party" request), or concerning an organization, or a particular topic of interest. FOIA requests also include requests made by requesters seeking records concerning themselves (i.e., "first-party" requests) when those requesters are not subject to the Privacy Act, such as non-U.S. citizens. Moreover, because all first-party requesters should be afforded the benefit of both the access provisions of the FOIA as well as those of the Privacy Act, FOIA requests also include any first-party requests where an agency determines that it must search beyond its Privacy Act "systems of records" or where a Privacy Act exemption applies, and the agency looks to FOIA to afford the greatest possible access. All requests which require the agency to utilize the FOIA in responding to the requester are included in this Report. Additionally, a FOIA request includes records referred to the agency for processing and direct response to the requester. It does not, however, include records for which the agency has received a consultation from another agency. (Consultations are reported separately in Section XII of this
- h. **Full Grant** an agency decision to disclose all records in full in response to a FOIA request
- i. **Full Denial** an agency decision not to release any records in response to a FOIA request because the records are exempt in their entirety under one or more of the FOIA exemptions, or because of a procedural reason, such as when no records could be located.
- j. **Glomar Response** An instance where the Department of Veterans Affairs will not confirm or deny the existence of the records requested.
- k. **Median Number** the middle, not average, number. For example, of 3, 7, and 14, the median number is 7.
- I. **Multi-Track Processing** a system in which simple requests requiring relatively minimal review are placed in one processing track and more voluminous and complex requests are placed in one or more other tracks. Requests granted expedited processing are placed in yet another track. Requests in each track are processed on a first in/first out basis.
 - i. **Expedited Processing** an agency will process a FOIA request on an expedited basis when a requester satisfies the requirements for expedited processing as set forth in the statute and in agency regulations.
 - ii. **Simple Request** a FOIA request that an agency using multi-track processing places in its fastest (non-expedited) track based on the low volume and/or simplicity of the records requested.
 - iii. **Complex Request** a FOIA request that an agency using multitrack processing places in a slower track based on the high volume and/or complexity of the records requested.

- m. **Partial Grant/Partial Denial** in response to a FOIA request, an agency decision to disclose portions of the records and to withhold other portions that are exempt under the FOIA, or to otherwise deny a portion of the request for a procedural reason.
- n. **Pending Request or Pending Administrative Appeal** a request or administrative appeal for which an agency has not taken final action in all respects.
- o. **Perfected Request** a request for records which reasonably describes such records and is made in accordance with published rules stating the time, place, fees (if any) and procedures to be followed.
- p. **Processed Request or Processed Administrative Appeal** a request or administrative appeal for which an agency has taken final action in all respects.
- q. Range in Number of Days the lowest and highest number of days to process requests or administrative appeals.
- r. **Time Limits** the time period in the statute for an agency to respond to a FOIA request (ordinarily twenty working days from receipt of a perfected FOIA request).
- 3. FOIA Exemptions. The VA does not provide information under the FOIA if the information requested meets one of FOIA's explicit exemptions. These exemptions apply if the requested information falls within one of the following categories:
 - a. **Exemption 1**: classified national defense and foreign relations information
 - b. **Exemption 2**: internal agency rules and practices
 - c. **Exemption 3**: information that is prohibited from disclosure by another federal law
 - d. **Exemption 4**: trade secrets and other confidential business information
 - e. **Exemption 5**: inter-agency or intra-agency communications that are protected by legal privileges
 - f. **Exemption 6**: information involving matters of personal privacy
 - g. **Exemption 7**: records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, to the extent that the production of those records (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of a confidential source, (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual
 - h. **Exemption 8**: information relating to the supervision of financial institutions
 - i. **Exemption 9**: geological information on wells

Note to Readers

I. Methodology

In early Fiscal Year (FY) 2009, VA procured an electronic FOIA tracking system to enter all new FOIA requests. In the spring of 2009, the VA implemented the system and the VA's Chief FOIA Officer made it mandatory for all FOIA requests to be entered into and tracked in the system. This necessitated the reliance on two distinct data sources to prepare this year's Annual FOIA report. For requests received between October 1, 2008 through May 31, 2009, information was collected and compiled manually. For requests received between June 1, 2009 through September 30, 2009 information was collected through the electronic system. The data was then combined and consolidated to create this report.

II. Data in this Year's Report

Problems inherent with manually collecting data for last year's report impact the FY 2009 report. For instance, numbers reported in the FY 2008 report were calculated utilizing a variety of reports which required FOIA Officers to manually calculate many numbers. In some cases it is likely these reports also contained Privacy Act requests, which were not to be counted on the FY 2008 report. Also, the dynamic nature of FOIA processing generates discrepancies: after the FY 2008 reporting period closed, some requests that had not been included in the report, but should have been, were closed and counted in this report. For example, in many cases, after a Privacy Act request was processed, it became evident it should have been counted in the Annual Report (because a FOIA exemption was used). For these reasons, there are discrepancies between VA's FY 2009 and FY 2008 reports.

With the acquisition of an automated system that is being used by all VA's FOIA Officers, we are optimistic that next year's report will reflect VA's FOIA operations more accurately.

XII.F - Discussion of Other FOIA Activities

The VA undertook several initiatives to improve FOIA administration and increase transparency:

- VA's acquisition of an electronic FOIA tracking system is enabling VA to provide more transparency into the processing of FOIA requests. FOIA requesters will be able to log on to the tracking system to monitor the status of their FOIA requests.
- In order to implement guidance from the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS), VA invited the Director of OGIS to speak to VA about the future of FOIA mediation.
- VA held 3 major training sessions for VA FOIA Officers to discuss recent developments in the FOIA. In February 2009, FOIA Officers convened to discuss FOIA Amendments that went into effect January 1, 2009, VA's General Counsel presented information about FOIA Appeals, and FOIA Officers were given a preview of the automated system VA acquired to track FOIA requests. In April 2009, VA FOIA Officers were convened to discuss the President's memo and the Attorney's General's memo on the FOIA. The Department was made aware of the President's and Secretary's open government and transparency goals. And in September 2009 to discuss preparing the FY2009 Annual FOIA report and receive training on changes to the report requirements that impact preparing the report and requests.
- VA distributed a FOIA Training DVD to all FOIA Officers. The DVD included a
 presentation from DOJ on the new amendments and the FOIA exemptions.
 FOIA Officers can view the DVD as many times at they want and on their
 schedule.
- VA continues to conduct Quarterly FOIA Snapshot reports. By successfully
 collecting and consolidating data from VA FOIA Officers on information about the
 number of FOIA requests they received each quarter, the number of request they
 have backlogged, and average processing times, VA is able to achieve a picture
 of what offices and programs receive a high volume of requests, and what offices
 struggle with backlogged FOIA requests, which help to identify where solutions
 are required.
- VA has been approached by other federal agencies to share its strategies for successful FOIA administration.
- VA is involved with the Association of Access Professionals to develop national certification for FOIA Officers.
