In light of the Department of Commerce's decision to extend by 30 days the deadlines for interested parties to file notice of intent to participate and substantive responses to its notice of institution in its review of fresh tomatoes from Mexico,<sup>1</sup> as well as Mexican Respondents request that the Commission extend its deadline for interested parties to respond to the Commission's Notice of Institution by 30 days,<sup>2</sup> the Commission has determined to extend the deadline for interested party responses to its Notice of Institution by 30 days. Accordingly, the deadline for interested parties to respond to the Commission's Notice of Institution is extended from January 2, 2013 to February 1, 2013.
