Snow Leopard Single File Instructions

Apple Macintosh OS 10.6 (Snow Leopard) -- Single File Instructions

The single file cannot be delivered by the usual method of using a web browser. To download the file, use a "real" FTP client -- either the built-in FTP client in Mac OS via the Terminal program or a program like Fetch. The following steps demonstrate using the built-in FTP client:

- 1. Launch Terminal from /Applications/Utilities
- 2. Type in: ftp isdp.nih.gov
- 3. When prompted, type in your username -- remember to precede your username with: NIH\
- 4. When prompted, type in your password
- 5. At the ftp> prompt, type in: binary
- 6. At the ftp> prompt, type in: lcd ~/Desktop
- 7. At the ftp> prompt, type in: cd /files/test/SBO_1/Apple/OSX
- 8. At the ftp> prompt, type in: get MacOS_10_6.dmg
- 9. After the file is downloaded -- this will take some time -- type in: bye
- 10. Type in: exit
- 11. Quit Terminal
- 12. The MacOS_10_6.dmg file can now be used to make a bootable dual-layer DVD of Mac OS 10.6
