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No.	OTHER TYPES OF SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES (Completed/On-Going During Reporting Month)
1	The OIG held an entrance conference on May 12, 2009 with DOL's Employee Benefits Security Administration (EBSA) to initiate its audit on the COBRA provisions in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. COBRA gives workers and their families who lose their health benefits the right to choose to continue group health benefits provided by their group health plan for limited periods of time. The audit's objective is to determine if EBSA has adequately planned and implemented COBRA provisions under ARRA.
2	The Assistant Inspector General for Audit made a presentation on May 14, 2009 in Seattle, WA to the Administration and Finance Committee of the National Association of State Workforce Agencies (NASWA) about the OIG's plans for oversight of DOL Recovery Act funds.  NASWA represents state administrators of unemployment insurance laws, employment services, training programs, and related activities provided through publicly-funded state workforce systems.
