


Find Data With Our Variable-Level Search

SAMHDA's unique **variable-level search** encompasses all our studies. A single query searches thousands of variables, helping users locate data of interest with ease. Results include hypertext links to studies and variables. This tool helps find specific variables:

- When variable names do not intuitively match their content
- When the full subject matter of a study is unknown
- For comparisons across studies
- For studies with large numbers of variables

Analyze Data Online


