Please be advised that The Department of the Treasury's Financial Management Service (FMS) has implemented a change to adhere with the NACHA Operating Rules, specifically the Company Identification Field (Company ID) within the Company/Batch Header Record. Previously all transactions sent by FMS utilized a "3" in the first position (also referred to as the Identification Code Designator-ICD) of the Company ID Field. Effective immediately the ICD will reference a "1", "3", or "9" followed by the appropriate Identification Number. A full description of the Company Identification field can be viewed on page 106 of the Operating Rules in the 2012 NACHA Operating Rules and Guidelines. Change:

- 1. The first position on the 'Company Identification' field position 41 contains the ANSI one-digit Identification Code Designator (ICD) as follows:
 - a. '1' = EIN provided for Child Support
 - b. 3' = DUNS
 - c. '9' = User Assigned Number
- 2. The FEIN for Child Support is moved from the 'Company Discretionary Data' field position 21-40 to the 'Company Identification' field position 42-50 with the '1' indicator in position 41 indicating an EIN.2012 NACHA Rules:
