



The Iowa HCUP State Inpatient Databases (SID) for 2009 (dated June or August 2010) and 2010 (dated September 2011) contain misleading discharge data from four hospitals accounting for about 11 percent of the files. The affected discharge data include incorrect reporting of the principal procedure and incorrect ordering of the additional procedures and secondary diagnoses. This problem also impacted the assignment of surgical DRGs as some surgical events were not factored into the assignment. The numbers of affected records are listed in the table below.
