

Minneapolis-St. Paul-Bloomington, MN-WI

- In 2011, the Minneapolis metropolitan area was the 10th largest export market in the United States, with merchandise shipments totaling \$26.2 billion. This is up \$3.0 billion (12.9 percent) from the \$23.2 billion in merchandise exported in 2010.
- For the top 50 U.S. merchandise export destinations, Minneapolis ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters to Canada (\$5.7 billion), China (\$4.2 billion), Mexico (\$2.9 billion), South Korea (\$1.4 billion), and the Philippines (\$589 million).
- Minneapolis ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters of Crop Production (\$7.6 billion), Computer and Electronic Products (\$3.2 billion), Machinery, Except Electrical (\$2.9 billion), Miscellaneous Manufactured Commodities (\$1.6 billion), and Food and Kindred Products (\$1.5 billion).
- In 2011, Minneapolis benefited from existing trade agreements, exporting \$8.6 billion to the NAFTA region and \$466 million to the CAFTA-DR region.
- 32.9 percent of Minneapolis's merchandise exports go to NAFTA countries.
