BPHC NCA FY11 MID-YEAR HIGHLIGHTS

This report includes information about some of the activities and publications of the 15 National Cooperative Agreements (NCAs) supported by the Bureau of Primary Health Care (BPHC) that are helpful resources for BPHC grantees.

WORKFORCE RECRUITMENT & RETENTION ACTIVITIES

STATE WORKFORCE DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS:

- Building upon the Primary Care Workforce State Strategy Forums supported by NCA partners in 2009 and 2010, ASTHO contracted with 3 states (ID, CO, OH) in 2010 and will contract with 1 state in 2011 to implement a state-wide strategy in a workforce demonstration project.
- Idaho developed a Community Apgar Questionnaire and pilot tested it in three communities to aid in recruitment of primary care providers. Colorado used funds to plan and implement data collection mechanisms improving the use of targeted provider incentives to address health professional shortages. WEB-BASED WORKFORCE RESOURCES:

- A revised toolkit on "Clinical Recruitment and Retention" is now available on the NACHC website. The
 first section of the Toolkit focuses on recruitment hiring the right person for the right position for the
 right community. The second section focuses on retention a critical strategic priority if health centers
 wish to retain quality staff and thus maintain quality services and financial stability.

 innovative policies such as payment reforms and scope of practice changes as well as how states can
