Subj: ARMED FORCES MEDICAL INTELLIGENCE CENTER (AFMIC)

Ref: (a) DOD Directive 6420.1 of 09 Oct 04

1. <u>Purpose</u>. To outline Navy responsibilities under reference (a) which reflect changes in the organization and conduct of Department of Defense (DOD) medical intelligence activities.

2. <u>Cancellation</u>. SECNAVINST 3800.9.

- 3. <u>Applicability</u>. This directive applies to all Navy and Marine Corps activities.
- 4. <u>Discussion</u>. AFMIC is a DOD intelligence production organization jointly staffed by personnel from each of the Military Departments, with authority to conduct day-to-day operations, subject to overall policy and regulatory control of the Director, Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA).
- 5. <u>Mission</u>. To act as the focal point in the DOD for compiling, producing, and distributing finished intelligence on foreign military and civilian medical capabilities, medical intelligence products and assessments.

(A. Responsibilities

- a. The Chief of Naval Operations shall:
- (1) Provide military staffing consistent with AFMIC requirements.

(2) On request of the Chair of the AFMIC Interdepartmental Advisory Panel provide nominees for the position of Director, AFMIC.
