Subj: STANDARD FORMAT REQUIREMENTS FOR SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL REPORTS

Ref: (a) American National Standard Institute (ANSI)
Z39.18-2005, "Scientific and Technical Reports:
Organization, Preparation, and Production"

- (b) DoD Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement
 235.072(d), "Final Scientific or Technical Reports"
- (c) SECNAV M-5210.1
- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To notify naval activities of standard format requirements for scientific and technical reports. This instruction updates references pertaining to format requirements and should be read in its entirety.
- 2. Cancellation. SECNAVINST 3900.29D.
- 3. <u>Action</u>. All scientific and technical reports prepared by, or for, the Department of the Navy shall comply with reference (a). Specifically:
- a. <u>In-House Reports</u>. All Navy and Marine Corps activities responsible for the preparation of scientific and technical reports will follow the provisions of reference (a) and will ensure that a completed Standard Form (SF) 298, Report Documentation Page, is included in every report distributed externally by any activity.
- b. <u>Contractor</u>, <u>Subcontractor</u>, <u>and Grantee Reports</u>. All Navy and Marine Corps scientific, technical, and/or other military personnel responsible for the management of scientific and technical work shall invoke reference (a) in their statement of procurement requirements for scientific and technical reports. In addition, reference (b) requires that a completed

SF 298, Report Documentation Page, be included in every copy of all scientific or technical reports, and that each responsible contracting officer will ensure this requirement is met.

- c. <u>Preparation of SF 298</u>. SF 298 shall be completed according to instructions on the form.
- d. <u>Implementation</u>. Additional implementing instructions are not required.
