SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority for NOAA-DOC Management of Working Capital Fund

TO: All NOAA Elements

1. Background - The Department of Commerce (DOC) imposes a variety of user charges on NOAA for Department provided services. Examples of these user charges services/accounts are:

2. Designation of NOAA's Working Capital Fund Manager - In the past there has not been a centralized NOAA authority for management of these funds nor an individual knowledgeable in all the accounts who could represent NOAA with the DOC Working Capital Fund Manager. Effective immediately, the Chief of MB/PB's Integration and Control Division (MB/PB1) is hereby designated NOAA's Working Capital Fund Manager. This official will participate in establishing DOC-NOAA ground rules governing these funds, will furnish DOC with estimated NOAA requirements, will receive all DOC assessments, will evaluate them against established, agreed upon, DOC-NOAA ground rules, and will authorize payments to DOC. This official will work with NOAA's regular user agents and will provide a coordinated and centralized information and control focus for NOAA managers and for NOAA users of the various user charge accounts.

3. Participating Offices - Various NOAA offices involved in DOC user charges are requested to establish working arrangements with MB/PB1 to enable that official to receive information needed to permit coordinated control and management of all of the NOAA user funds that must be paid to the DOC Working Capital Fund.
