AUTHORITY TO DO WHAT: For purposes of the Coastal Energy Impact Program (CEIP) and Coastal Zone Management Fund (CZMF):

- 1) to establish and implement administrative controls and procedures for the processing and management of the CEIP/CZMF.
- 2) to exercise "binding" authority for NOAA, including signature authority, securing necessary clearances from the NOAA Office of General Counsel, the Department of Commerce, and other Federal departments and offices that may be involved.
- 3) to maintain liaison with other Federal agencies, State and local governments, regional organizations or governments, loan recipients, and the general public, through appropriate means including promulgations in the Federal Register.

RESERVED AUTHORITY: All other reservations as specified in NOAA Circular 83-38.
