Submitting an NIH Application?

Major changes for due dates on or after January 25, 2010:

Restructured application forms

New instructions including shorter page limits

For ALL competing applications: New, Renewal, Resubmission, and Revision

Steps for Success:

- Read about requirement changes **now** so that you can begin writing your Research Strategy
- In December, go back to the updated Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) or reissued Parent Announcement and download the new application package and instructions
- 3) Read the new application instructions carefully
- 4) For **due dates on or after January 25**, submit your electronic and paper applications using the new application forms
