- VetSuccess.gov is a comprehensive integrated Intra/Internet-based data network that will improve the effectiveness and efficiency of a virtual one stop employment center.
- Developed to enhance program management capabilities through state of the art tracking and reporting capabilities.
- Capable of managing and simplifying employment services activities used by veterans, VR&E staff, and other Service Providers.

• After you have selected your media player and connection speed the page will update and list the Introductory Videos available. Each video includes a scenario on how the track might apply to you.








How to Apply

- Just click on the website and the VONAPP process will appear.
- VONAPP requires that the user create a User ID and password.
- VONAPP allows the veteran:
 - To apply for VR&E benefits through the VA On-Line Application (VONAPP) website;
 - Provides instructions on how to apply by mail








How to Apply

- The VONAPP (Veterans On Line Applications) website is an official U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) website, which enables veterans to apply for benefits using the Internet.
- VONAPP allows U.S. military veterans and some service members within six months of separation or retirement to apply for compensation, pension, and vocational rehabilitation benefits.
- VONAPP also has a link to VA Form 10-10EZ, Application for Health Benefits.








Vocational Educational Counseling

 - Exploring educational or training facilities, which might be utilized to achieve an occupational goal.








Military Transferable Skills Identifier

• It also identifies the required training for the occupations, the outlook, earnings, related occupations, sources and other significant points.








Occupation Profiles

 - Simply click on the desired occupational group or scroll down for more selections.








Industry Profiles

 - Simply click on the desired occupational group or scroll down for more selections.








Industry Profiles

• Selecting this link will hyperlink you to **CareerOneStop**.








State Information

 - <u>Service Locator</u> allows the user to find a CareerOneStop closest to them.








The Labor Market
