Brandon C. Willis is Acting Administrator of the Risk Management Agency (RMA), U.S. Department of Agriculture. RMA provides economic protection and risk management tools to America's farmers and ranchers primarily through federally sponsored crop insurance delivered and serviced by private insurance companies. He is also Acting Manager of the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC), and a non-voting member of the FCIC Board of Directors.

Brandon Willis is also a Senior Advisor to Secretary Vilsack working on agriculture issues related to the farm safety net and the farm bill. Before this, he worked as the Deputy Administrator for Farm Programs at the Farm Service Agency (FSA) overseeing administration of FSA's farm programs. Before joining FSA, Brandon served as the Agriculture Legislative Assistant for U.S. Senator Max Baucus.

Brandon earned his bachelor's degree in crop and soil science from Utah State University, a law degree from the University of Wyoming and a master's degree in agricultural law from the University of Arkansas.

He grew up on a sheep ranch in northern Utah and managed his family's raspberry farm, *Bursting Berries*.
