- **RE:** Fraudulent Letters of Confirmation

The Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC) has been advised by TCF National Bank, Minneapolis, MN, that certain "confirmation of funds" letters, issued from the bank's <u>Arlington Heights Road branch office</u>, were issued without the authority of the bank. These letters, also referred to as "Bank Capability Letters," are addressed to several different entities and signed by both the branch manager and assistant branch manager. The letters refer to transactions involving Medium Term Notes/Medium Term Senior Subordinated Bank Debentures in amounts of \$500 million or more, in total or per tranche. Please be advised that these letters have no value.
