Former Border Patrol Agent Sentenced for Sexual Assault

RIVERSIDE - CA— A former U.S. Border Patrol Agent (BPA) was sentenced to eight years in state prison after pleading guilty October 23 to charges that he sexually assaulted and kidnapped a female Mexican tourist in 2009.

The Department of Homeland Security, Office of Inspector General, conducted a joint investigation of BPA Luis E. Hermosillo with the Riverside County Sheriff's Department after it received a sexual assault complaint from the woman. The victim alleged that BPA Hermosillo inspected her vehicle at a Riverside County checkpoint. As the victim drove away, Hermosillo followed her and executed a traffic stop. During the traffic stop, Hermosillo ordered the victim to drive to a remote location, where he then sexually assaulted the victim in front of her two young children. Following the assault, Hermosillo reportedly asked the victim to drive to a dinner and dancing and gave her his phone number, which investigators later used to track him down and secure evidence of his guilt.
