

Marathon Engineering Diversity PhD Fellowship

The Marathon Engineering Diversity PhD Fellowship Program was established to encourage outstanding graduate students, especially women and minorities, to pursue the doctorate in engineering and encourage engineering education as a profession. The prospective Ph.D. candidate should be a US citizen or permanent resident and seeking a degree in fields of interest to Marathon Oil Company—chemical engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, civil engineering or petroleum engineering.

The Marathon Engineering Diversity Graduate Fellowship will provide a \$20,000 stipend and an additional \$15,000 annually by the home department of the graduate student, for an overall package of \$35,000 per year for a maximum of up to four years. The amount is awarded for the 12 month fiscal year.

Program Criteria

- Applicant must have a demonstrated commitment to diversity and the teaching profession. The applicant will be required to participate in at least one (per year) of the Office of Diversity Programs educational outreach activities and teach assigned sessions of Engineering 1050.
- Applicant will be reviewed annually for satisfactory academic progress, including full time enrollment status and maintaining an overall and semester GPA of 3.5.
- Applicant will be reviewed annually to assess a continued commitment to a career in engineering
 education through the submission of an annual report, which will include research updates and educational
 outreach activities.
- Applicant must submit undergraduate GPA, GRE scores, a current resume or vitae, transcripts of all academic work, and a personal statement about a faculty career.
