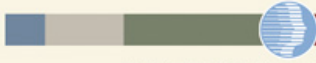

MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter II, Section 31, Federally Qualified Health Center Services, Subsection 31.09 – Billing Instructions, page 11.

“For Core and Ambulatory Services, as described under Covered Services-Section 31.04, providers must bill T1015 and include the appropriate revenue codes. When billing, providers must use a UB 04 claim form. Effective October 1, 2010, in addition to billing the code T1015 for Core and Ambulatory Services, providers must also report all services provided including all procedures with the standard CPT and HCPC5 codes on the UB 04 claims form for reporting purposes.”

MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter II, Section 31, Federally Qualified Health Center Services, Subsection 31.07 – Reimbursement, page 10.

“Reimbursement is generally limited to one core service visit, and/or one ambulatory service visit per day. Reimbursement for a second core visit is also covered if the member has both an encounter with a physician, physician assistant, advanced nurse practitioner or visiting nurse, and in addition to that encounter, is seen by a licensed clinical psychologist, clinical social worker, clinical professional counselor or a clinical nurse specialist licensed as a psychiatric registered nurse on the same day. An additional visit of any other kind will only be reimbursed for unforeseen circumstances as documented in the member’s record. The goal remains to treat the whole individual during one visit.”

Subsection 65.02-9 – Clinicians, page 2.

“Clinician is an individual appropriately licensed or certified in the state or province in which he or she practices, practicing within the scope of that licensure or certification, and qualified to deliver treatment under this Section. A clinician includes the following: licensed clinical professional counselor (LCPC); licensed clinical professional counselor-conditional (LCPC-conditional); licensed clinical social worker (LCSW); licensed master social worker conditional clinical (LMSW-conditional clinical); licensed marriage and family counselor (LMFT); licensed marriage and family counselor-conditional (LMFT-conditional); Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselors (LADC), Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselors (CADC); physician; psychiatrist; advanced practice registered nurse psychiatric and mental health practitioner (APRN-PMH-NP); advanced practice registered nurse psychiatric and mental health clinical nurse specialists (APRN-PMH-CNS); psychological examiner; physicians assistant (PA); registered nurse or licensed clinical psychologist.”

“In order to provide substance abuse outpatient therapy, must be Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselors (LADC), Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselors (CADC); or a Physician (MD or DO), Licensed Clinical Psychologist, Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor (LCPC), Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT), Registered Professional Nurse.”
