General Information for the Clerk

This form may be used when only one of the debtors in a joint case is discharged. This can occur if the other debtor is dismissed from the case, converts to another chapter, signs a waiver of discharge, or is denied discharge.

Form 18J may be used for the discharge of two joint chapter 7 debtors. Official Form 18 is used for the discharge in a chapter 7 case filed by an individual debtor. See the instructions for Form 18J for additional information for the clerk.
