

COL Gordon T. McMillan

COL Gordon T. McMillan concurrently serves as the Deputy Director J9 and Deputy Commander Joint Transportation Reserve Unit for USTRANSCOM, Scott AFB, IL.

COL McMillan began his military career as an enlisted member with the Kansas Army National Guard in 1982. He received his commission as a Second Lieutenant through the Early Commission Program from the Reserve Officers Training Corps at Wichita State University, Wichita, KS in 1984, where he later graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice in 1987. From 1987 to 1991, COL McMillan held platoon and detachment level commander positions in several units within the Army National Guard, until his transfer to the Army Reserve in 1991. From 1991 until 1997, COL McMillan served in several assignments as a traditional reservist and as an Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA), until his entrance into the Active Guard Reserve Program in 1997.

COL McMillan assignments have included a variety of logistical and operational duties, prior to his current assignment. These include serving as the joint transportation officer during OPERATION JOINT GUARD and JOINT ENDEAVOR, future operations and force flow officer during OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM and OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM and various assignments within the S3 and G3 communities.
