Software Requirements

- Critique templates contain "form" functionality such as drop-down fields and protected sections
- Do not unprotect and re-protect the document (data loss may occur)
- Templates are designed to function best using Microsoft Word, and are compatible with OpenOffice.org (a free open-source office software suite)
 - o OpenOffice.org is available at http://www.openoffice.org
 - If using OpenOffice, you MUST save your critique as a Microsoft Word 97/2000/XP (.doc) file before uploading it into IAR
- Mac users who experience difficulties with templates in Microsoft Word should run automatic updates to ensure use of the latest version of Microsoft Word
- Plain text versions of the templates (with reduced functionality) are available from the SRO upon request

Tips and Tricks for the Unprotected Sections

- Unprotected Sections are:
 - o Overall Impact
 - Scored Review Criteria
- Do not record scores for overall impact or individual criteria on the templates
- Enter your comments directly on the template (instead of cutting and pasting) to retain bullets and formatting
- If you must paste text, use paste-special and choose "unformatted text" to retain bullets
- Use a hard return at the end of a bullet to create the next bullet
- The application number and PI name at the top of the critique do not communicate with IAR; these fields are provided to help ensure correct matching of the critiques to the applications

Tips and Tricks for the Protected Sections

- Protected Sections are:
 - o Additional Review Criteria

- o Additional Review Considerations
- o Additional Comments to the Applicant
- Protection is necessary to enable functions such as drop-down boxes
- Gray shading indicates the presence of a form field to record your assessment (either as a drop-down selection or a comments field)
- The Microsoft Word spelling and grammar check function is **unavailable** in protected sections
- For Microsoft Word 2003 users, hyperlinks will be **inaccessible** in protected sections; use the hyperlink at the top of the critique template instead

Finishing Touches

- Save the template with a meaningful file name (but do not include any information that could reveal your identity)
- Upload the critique to IAR
