Measuring Up: Is NOAA Meeting Surveyors' Needs?

The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), National Geodetic Survey (NGS), has developed a performance metric to evaluate how well it is enabling counties with accurate positioning capacity to the centimeter level relative to the National Spatial Reference System (NSRS). One of the key components of this effort is to develop points of contact for geospatial issues in each county throughout the United States.

We are looking for County Surveyors, GIS Professionals and others who can speak for the needs of individual Counties to fill out a brief web-based County Scorecard.

Developed over the past three years in partnership with National Association of County Surveyors (NACS), the County Scorecard gauges local use of NOAA positioning tools/services and customer satisfaction. It contains 23 questions specifically focusing on infrastructure, NGS models and tools, NGS capacity building and outreach, and customer satisfaction.
