The Nuclear and Radiological Engineering Fellowship Program at the Georgia Institute of Technology

Executive Summary:

The Nuclear and Radiological Engineering (NRE) program in the Woodruff School at Georgia Tech is proposing to create a nuclear and radiological engineering fellowship program. The fellowship program will provide 8 one-year fellowships (2 fellowships each year for 4 years) for highly qualified graduate students. The proposed fellowships will cover up to the cost of tuition, mandatory student fees, books and supplies, and stipends. The fellowship program will focus on the recruiting and retention of top nuclear engineering student who come to Georgia Tech to obtain an MS or Ph.D. degree in nuclear engineering.
